
#### 1. International Webinar

Department of History celebrated Onam Festival (Charithronam) from 20 to 24 August 2021. Second year students of the department organized varieties of program on the occasion.








## 5. Webinar on Research Methodology





## 7. Gandhi Jayanti Quiz


